READ ALL SAFETY WARNINGS AND INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE USING THIS PRODUCT.

WARNING: WHEN USING AN ELECTRICAL PRODUCT, BASIC PRECAUTIONS SHOULD ALWAYS BE FOLLOWED TO AVOID ELECTRIC SHOCK, FIRE, AND/OR SERIOUS INJURY, INCLUDING THE FOLLOWING:

- Fully assemble product prior to use.
- Do not store or charge battery outdoors or on wet surfaces. Do not allow battery to get wet.
- Use Indoors Only. Do not immerse. Use only on carpet moistened by the cleaning process.
- This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.
- Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.
- Use only as described in this manual. Use only Hoover® recommended parts and accessories.
- Do not use charger with damaged cord or plug. If appliance or charger is not working as it should, has been dropped, damaged, left outdoors, or dropped into water, call customer service at 1300 698 130 (AUS) / 0800 126 688 (NZ) prior to continuing use.
- Do not pull or carry charger by cord, use cord as a handle, close a door on cord, or pull cord around sharp edges or corners. Do not place product on cord. Do not run appliance over cord. Keep cord away from heated surfaces.
- Do not unplug charger by pulling on cord. To unplug charger, grasp the plug, not the cord.
- Do not handle charger including charger plug and charger terminals, or appliance with wet hands or with metallic objects (eq. keys).
- Do not put any object into openings. Do not use with any opening blocked; keep free of dust, lint, hair, and anything that may reduce air flow.

- Keep hair, loose clothing, fingers, and all parts of body away from openings and moving parts.
- Turn off all controls before removing battery pack from your product.
- Do not use to pick up flammable or combustible liquids, such as gasoline, or fine wood sandings, or use in areas where they may be present.
- Do not pick up anything that is burning or smoking, such as cigarettes, matches, or hot ashes.
- Do not use without Filters and/or Tanks in place.
- Do not clean over floor electrical outlets.
- To Reduce the Risk of Fire and Electric Shock due to internal component damage, use only Hoover cleaning solutions intended for use with this appliance.
- Always install float before any wet pick-up operation.

- Prevent unintentional starting. Ensure the product is powered off before connecting to battery pack, picking up or carrying the appliance. Carrying the appliance with your finger on the switch or energizing appliance that have the switch on invites accidents.
- Disconnect the battery pack from the appliance before making any adjustments, removing parts, or storing appliance. Such preventative safety measures reduce the risk of starting the appliance accidentally.
- Recharge only with the charger specified by the manufacturer. A charger that is suitable for one type of battery pack may create a risk of injury

- and fire when used with another battery pack. Do not use charger outdoors.
- Use appliance only with specially designated battery packs. Use of any other battery packs may create a risk of injury and fire.
- When battery pack is not in use, keep it away from other metal objects, like paper clips, coins, keys, nails, screws or other small metal objects, that can make a connection from one terminal to another. Shorting the battery terminals together may cause burns or a fire.
- Under abusive conditions, liquid may be ejected from the battery; avoid contact. If contact accidentally occurs, flush with water. If liquid contacts eyes, additionally seek medical help. Liquid ejected from battery may cause irritation or burns.
- Do not use a battery pack or appliance that is damaged or modified. Damaged or modified batteries may exhibit unpredictable behaviour resulting in fire, explosion or risk of injury.
- Do not expose a battery pack or appliance to fire or excessive temperatures.
- Follow all charging instructions and do not charge the battery pack or appliance outside of the temperature range specified in the instructions. Charging improperly or at temperatures outside of the specified range may damage the battery and increase the risk of fire.
- During charging, the pack and ambient temperature should be between 5° and 30°C.
- Do not charge battery in a damp or wet location.
 Store your charger in a cool dry place between
 10 and 25°C. Do not store outside or in vehicles
- Have servicing performed by a qualified repair person using only identical replacement parts.
 This will ensure that the safety of the product is maintained.
- Do not modify or attempt to repair the appliance or the battery pack as applicable except as indicated in the instructions for use and care.
- Do not incinerate the charger, battery, or appliance even if it is severely damaged. The batteries can explode in a fire.
- Remove battery when the cleaner is not in use and before servicing.
- The charger is for indoor use only. Be sure to always keep the battery and charger in a dry place.
- Use extra care when cleaning on stairs. To avoid personal injury or damage, and to prevent the products from falling, always place product at bottom of stairs or on floor. Do not place product on stairs or furniture.

CAUTION: TO REDUCE THE RISK OF DAMAGE

- Avoid picking up hard, sharp objects with this product, as they may cause damage.
- Do not use sharp objects to clean out hose as they can cause damage.
- Store appropriately indoors in a dry place. Do not expose machine to freezing temperatures.
- To assist in reducing drying time, be certain the area is well ventilated when using detergents and other cleaners with this machine.
- Do not store with solution in tanks.
- Water will drip from the brushes and underside of the product after use and may puddle. To avoid damage to wood and laminate flooring and to avoid potential slip hazard, after use (a) do not leave the product on wood and laminate surfaces for extended periods of time, and (b)

- place unit on absorbent material (such as a towel) to soak up drips.
- With brushes on, do not allow cleaner to sit in one location for an extended period of time as damage to the floor can result.
- Do not use extractor on hard floors. Using this product on hard floors may scratch or damage your floor.

THERMAL PROTECTION

A thermal protector has been designed into your cleaner to protect it from overheating. When the thermal protector activates the cleaner will stop running. If this happens proceed as follows:

- 1. Turn cleaner OFF and remove battery pack.
- 2. Empty dirty water tank.
- 3. Inspect the brush roll cover for any obstructions. Clear obstructions if present.
- After the battery pack is removed and the motor cools for 30 minutes, reinstall the battery pack. The thermal protector will deactivate and cleaning may continue.

If thermal protector continues to activate after following the above steps, call Customer Service at 1300 698 130 (AUS) / 0800 126 688 (NZ)

LITHIUM-ION BATTERIES

The battery must be collected, recycled or disposed of in an environmentally sound manner. Please follow local regulations for battery disposal.

BATTERY SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

- Replace the battery with a Hoover ONEPWR battery only. Use of another battery may present a risk of fire or explosion.
- Do not attempt to open or disassemble the battery, remove any component projecting from the battery terminals and do not dispose of in a fire.
- The battery and charger have no user serviceable parts. Fire or injury may result.
- Prior to disposal, protect exposed terminals with heavy insulating tape to prevent shorting.
 The battery is to be disposed of safely at your local battery recycling centre.
- When the battery pack is not in use, keep it away from other metal objects that can make a connection from one terminal to another
- Shorting the battery terminals together may cause burns or a fire.
- In case of battery leakages avoid any contact with the skin. If liquid comes into contact with the skin, wash immediately with soap and water, then neutralise with lemon juice or vinegar. If liquid gets into the eyes, flush with clean water for at least 10 minutes, then seek immediate medical attention.
- To reduce the risk of fire, personal injury, and product damage due to short circuit, never immerse the tool, battery pack, or charger in fluid or allow fluid to flow inside them. Corrosive or conductive fluids, such as seawater, certain industrial chemicals, and bleach or bleach-containing products, etc., can cause a short circuit.

ASSEMBLY

Fully assemble product prior to use.

GETTING STARTED




Slide the handle into the base until you hear a "click."



Charge the battery. INSERT battery into unit. To remove the battery press both buttons on the battery and slide the battery off the unit.







Hook brush roll cover underneath hook rail.



And rock into place.

CAUTION: Do not clean over floor electrical outlets. Water will drip from the brushes and underside of the product after use and may puddle. To avoid damage to wood and laminate flooring and to avoid potential slip hazard, after use (a) do not leave the product on wood and laminate surfaces and move to a hard surface and (b) place cleaner on an absorbent material (such as a towel) to soak up drips.

FILL THE CLEAN WATER TANK



2.

Add warm water (max 40°C) to the water fill line, then add Hoover solution to the solution fill line. Replace tab.



Align Clean Water Tank with the body of the cleaner and rock FIRMLY into place.

MACHINE NOTIFICATIONS



LED screen explanation:

- SPOT icon lights up when Spot Mode is turned
- · WASH icon lights up when unit is being pushed forward. Unit will automatically dispense solution and water.
- DRY icon lights up when unit is being pulled backward. Unit will automatically extract.
- DRY ONLY icon lights up when Dry Only mode is turned ON.
- CHECK TANKS icon lights up when the dirty water tank needs emptied.
- The Battery icon will update based on how much battery you have left. When last battery light is blinking you will be forced in to DRY ONLY mode to avoid saturating your carpets.

IMPURIANI: When using the machine, basic safety precautions should always be observed. Take care not to oversaturate flooring. Continue using dry strokes until little water is visibly passing through the nozzle. For best results, HOOVER® recommends rinsing carpet with water only. This removes residual carpet cleaning solution, especially for heavily soiled areas. Avoid saturating carpet.

OPERATION

BEFORE YOU BEGIN CLEANING

- Where possible, move furniture out of area to be cleaned. Place aluminium foil or wax paper under legs of furniture too heavy to move to prevent wood finishes from staining carpet. Pin up furniture skirts and drapes. To avoid damage to wood floors underneath area rugs or carpet, place waterproof material (such as plastic) underneath them before cleaning.
- Vacuum carpet thoroughly with a Hoover vacuum before use.
- (3) For best results, pre-teat tough stains with a HOOVER® Spot and Stain Remover
- (4) Test for colourfastness in a small, hidden area. Gently rub surface with a dampened white cloth. Wait ten minutes and check for colour removal or bleed with a white paper towel.

NOTE: Press the + button to turn on Spot mode for set in stains and spots. Press the - button to turn on Dry Only Mode for fast dry time

OPERATION



Slowly move forward. The cleaner will automatically dispense the optimal amount of water and cleaning solution.



Slowly pull backward. The cleaner will automatically dry your carpets by extracting the water and cleaning solution.



When you finish cleaning but further drying is required, press the '-' button on the handle. Unit will switch to DRY ONLY Mode. The Dry Only mode will extract remaining water from your carpet. Continue in this mode until little water is visibly passing through the brush roll cover.



For deep set-in stains, press the '+' button to switch to SPOT Mode. Machine will dispense the optimal amount of solution and water to help scrub out set in spots and stains.

For best results, HOOVER® recommends rinsing the carpet with clean water only. This will remove residual carpet cleaning solution from your carpets. To rinse with clean water only, empty clean water tank and refill with water only and then repeat steps 4 through 6.

MAINTENANCE

WARNING: To reduce the risk of electric shock, always install float before any wet pick-up

Always switch off the machine and remove the battery before carrying out any maintenance or troubleshooting.

To avoid spillage, do not rock unit backwards when dirty water tank is full.

HOW TO EMPTY

1.

Turn the unit off and take out battery.



Grab the Dirty Water Tank handle and pull up to release. Remove Tank from carpet cleaner base at an angle.



Place on a flat surface and unlatch Dirty Water Tank lid to remove top of tank.



Empty tank, rinse, and allow to air dry.

HOW TO CLEAN FILTER



To remove filter and float, twist filter assembly counterclockwise to remove. Rinse with water, then twist filter assembly back into place.

NOTE: Keeping the filter clean is critical to maintain strong suction performance.

AUTO SHUT OFF FLOAT:


Your carpet cleaner is equipped with a shut off float within your Dirty Water Tank. When the Dirty Water Tank becomes full, the float will rise, shutting off the air flow through the brush roll cover. Once the air flow is shut off, empty the Dirty Water Tank. If dirty water tank indicator is flashing empty dirty water tank.

IMPORTANT: Regarding the Dirty Water Tank: For full suction it is important that the Dirty Water Tank Lid is securely in place. If misplaced, poor or no suction will result.


For full suction, it is important that the Dirty Water Tank is properly secured before cleaning.

HOW TO REMOVE & CLEAN BRUSH ROLL COVER

WARNING: Risk of personal injury - brush roll may suddenly restart - remove battery before cleaning or servicing.




To prevent possible leaking, remove and empty Clean Water Tank and Dirty Water Tank.



With handle in upright position, and dirty water tank removed lift up on the brush roll cover release then pull brush roll cover forward to remove from carpet cleaner.

CAUTION, pull brush roll cover carefully outwards and not upwards.



Rinse debris from brush roll cover. Use the nozzle cleanout tool to pull debris from inside the cover.




Hook brush roll cover underneath hook rail and then rock into place.


IMPORTANT: The brush roll cover must be in the proper position for the cleaner to have proper suction.

HOW TO CHANGE AND CLEAN BRUSHES: HOW TO REMOVE

WARNING: Risk of personal injury - brush roll may suddenly restart - remove battery before cleaning or servicing.




To prevent possible leaking, remove Clean Water Tank and Dirty Water Tank.



With handle in upright position, follow "How to Remove and Clean Brush roll cover."




Grab Side A and pull up to remove. Repeat on the other brush.



The brushes can be cleaned under running water.

HOW TO REPLACE BRUSHES



At an angle, align Side B on the brush to the drive gear.



Press Tab A down until brush snaps in place.

LUBRICATION: The motor and brush roll are equipped with bearings which contain sufficient lubrication for their lifetime. The addition of lubricant could cause damage. Do not add lubricant to motor or brush roll.

STORAGE: Before storing: Empty Clean Water Tank and let air dry. Replace on cleaner. Empty Dirty Water Tank, clean filter of dirt/ debris, rinse tank and lid thoroughly with clean water and let air dry. Allow brushes and underside of carpet cleaner to air dry thoroughly before storing carpet cleaner on a carpeted or wood surface.

WARNING: To reduce the risk of injury from moving parts - switch off the machine and remove the battery before carrying out any servicing or maintenance or troubleshooting. Do not use cleaner without brushes in place.

Loss of suction	1. Dirty water tank not installed properly	1. Turn power OFF, remove and reinstall dirty water tank
	2. Dirty water tank is full	2. Turn power OFF, empty and reinstall the dirty water tank
	3. Brush roll cover is not installed properly	3. Turn power OFF, remove brush roll cover, reinstall brush roll and cover according to instructions on page 2
	4. Brush roll cover hose behind brush roll is clogged	4. Turn power OFF, follow instructions for care of brush roll and cover on page 3
	5. Filter is clogged	5. Clean and allow filter to dry completely
